Services Covered by Medicare Part B



Can be completed annually, or more often, if recommended by your provider(s)

Why should I obtain Annual Preventive Services?



They are available to you at no or low cost



Find health problems early and prevent late-life diseases and chronic illnesses



Help monitor your health status and obtain yearly tailored preventive plans for you

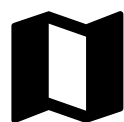

Why are these Preventive Services important to get annually?

What are the services and how much do they cost to beneficiaries?

Breast Cancer Screening

Women 40 years and older

Diabetes Screening

Have high blood pressure **AND/OR**

Dyslipidemia **AND/OR**

65 or older **AND/OR**

Overweight **AND/OR**

Personal or family history of diabetes or high blood sugar

Lung Cancer Screening

Age 55-77 **AND**

Currently asymptomatic lung cancer **AND**

Current or former smoker **AND**

Average(d) 1 pack a day for at least 30 years

Prostate Cancer Screening

Men 50 years and older

Glaucoma Tests

Have diabetes **AND/OR**

Family history of glaucoma **AND/OR**

Hispanic and 65 years or older **AND/OR**

African-American and 50 years or older

Immunizations

Vaccination history **AND/OR** risk factor(s)

Yearly "Wellness" Visit

Had Medicare Part B for at least 12 months

Breast Cancer Screening

Breast cancer is the most common non-skin cancer and second leading cause of cancer death in women

Diabetes Screening

Diabetes causes your blood sugar to be too high, resulting in poor health

Lung Cancer Screening

Very common cancer in older adults, with over 50% of patients diagnosed over the age of 65

Prostate Cancer Screening

1 in 8 men will develop prostate cancer in their lifetime

Glaucoma Tests

Glaucoma is the leading cause of blindness in adults over the age 60

Immunizations

Over 70% of seasonal flu-related deaths occur in adults 65 and older

Yearly "Wellness" Visit

Can receive a cognitive assessment and develop a personalized prevention plan to help you stay healthy

Annual Service Cost to Members

Screening Mammogram Pay Nothing

Up to 2 blood screening tests Pay Nothing

Low Dose Computed Tomography Pay Nothing

Prostate-Specific Antigen test and/or digital rectal exam Pay Nothing

Eye examination Pay 20%

Flu and COVID-19 Pay Nothing

Routine physical, health risk test, and personalized health advice Pay Nothing
